




### **Story time**

### You'll need


- Pom poms or feathers
- Glue
- Scissors
- Animal template photocopied on thick card
- Colouring Crayons




#### **Instructions**

- 1. Photocopy the animal template onto thick card.
- 2. Depending on skill level of children either pre-cut out animal templates or allow children to cut out around the outline.
- 3. Children are to colour in the animals encourage children to use colours similar to those of the animal.
- 4. Once children are ready, they can use their fingers or tweezers to pick up the pom poms and glue to the card! To make their animals CUTE and FLUFFY!
